

Sample Lesson

Lesson 1: Narrative Writing

Objective: Students will be able to write a narrative essay that includes a clear beginning, middle, and end.

Materials:

* Mentor text: "The Tell-Tale Heart" by Edgar Allan Poe * Writing paper * Pencils or pens

Procedure:

1. Read the mentor text aloud to the class. 2. Ask students to identify the beginning, middle, and end of the story. 3.
