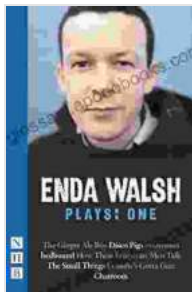

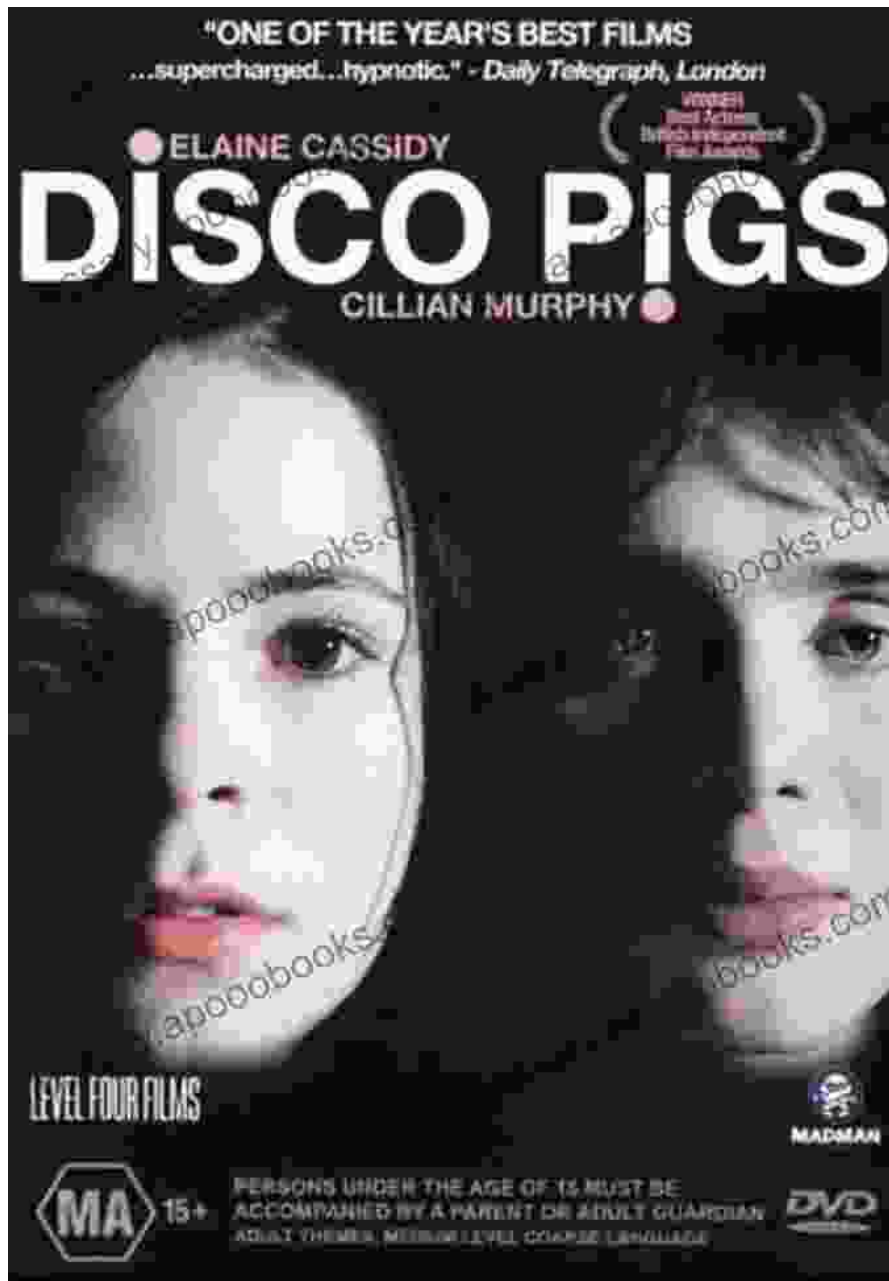

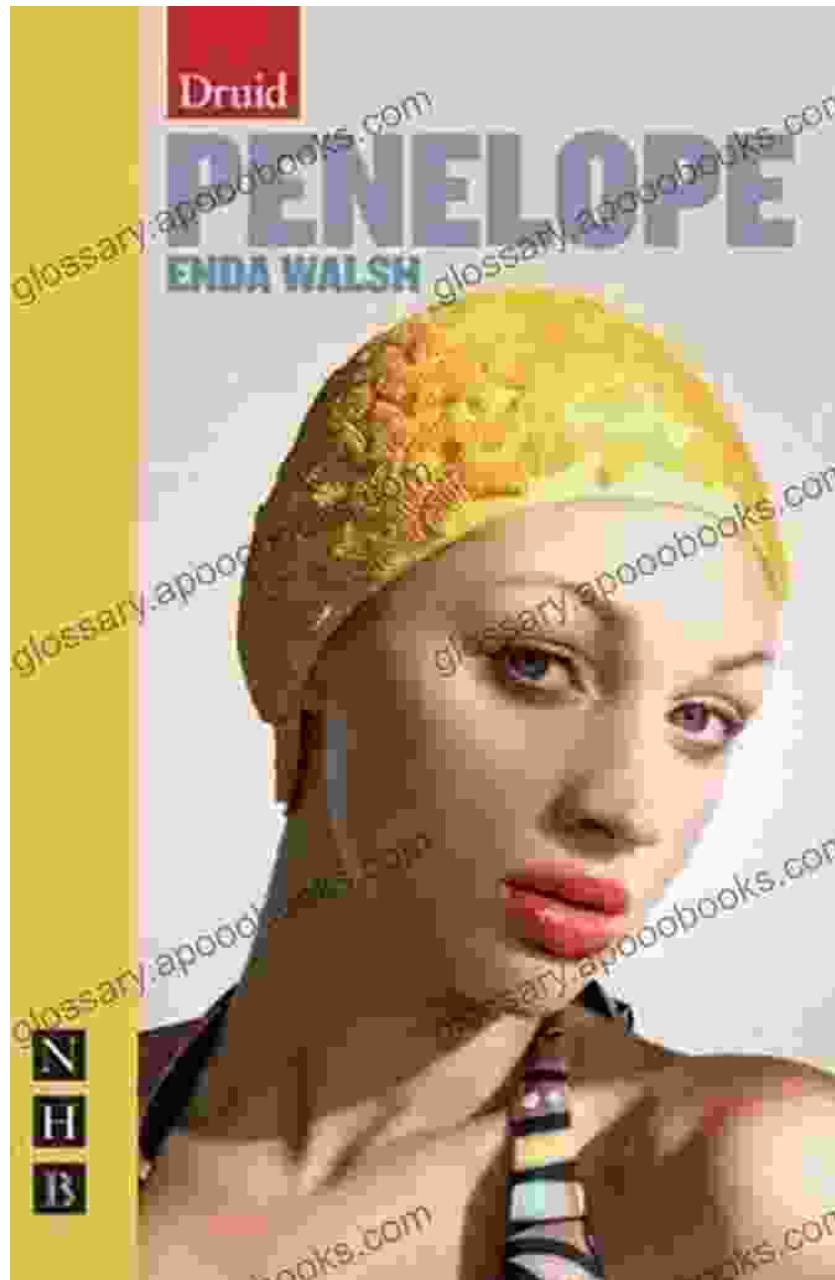
Disco Pigs (1996)

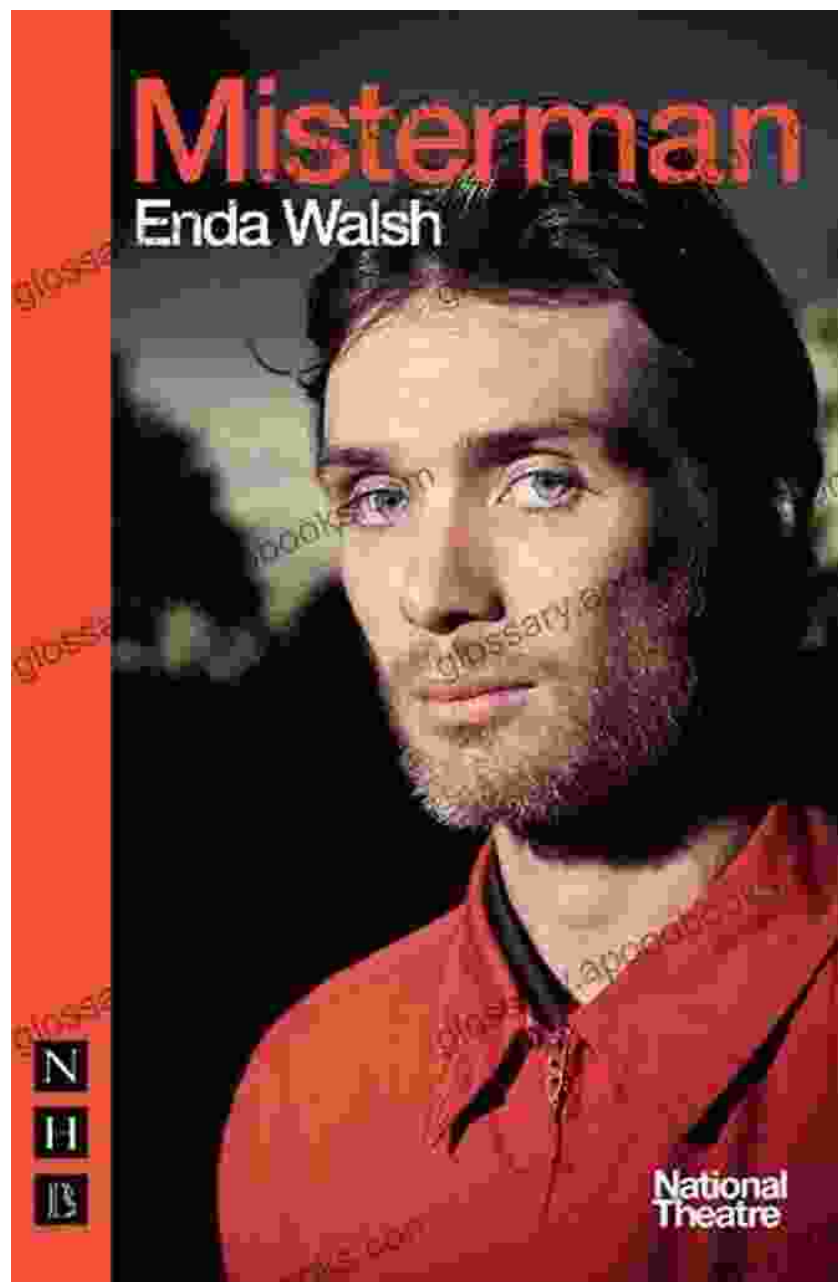

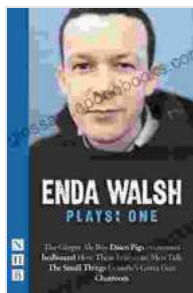
