


What Are the PARCC ELA Literacy Assessments?

The PARCC ELA Literacy Assessments are a series of three tests that measure students' reading, writing, and language usage skills. The tests are:

 Reading Test: The Reading Test measures students' ability to read and understand complex texts. The test includes passages from a variety of genres, including fiction, non-fiction, and poetry.



- Stay calm on test day. The most important thing is to stay calm and focused on test day. If you've prepared well, you'll do great!



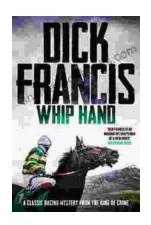
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
